What is Rush Creek Cadet Council?

Simple Answer - A group of Cadet clubs within a reasonable distance of each other that meet regularly for cooperative efforts in counselor education and Cadet activities. We subscribe to the mission statement that is set forth by Corps - "Helping boys to grow more Christlike in all areas of life".

Our geographic boundaries extend approximately to Bauer Road in the north, 72^{nd} Ave. in the west, the Ottawa county, Kent county border in the east, and Perry Street in the south.

Counselor education, support programs, and resources that are offered by Rush Creek Cadet council to its members include, but are not limited to:



- 1- **Monthly meetings** between August and May during which workshops and classes are presented that aid the counselor in merit badge and other projects and activities.
- 2 A Quartermaster to facilitate the purchase of items and supplies that are available from the Corps supply catalog.
- 3 Counselor and Jr. Counselor certification classes.
- 4 **An equipment Co-op** from which items can be rented or borrowed, some of these items include canoes, air rifles, ropes,

slingshots, cross country skis and more. Non-member use is subject to committee approval and special non-member rates.

- 5 A campgound of our own which contains 4 lodges, indoor archery range, obstacle course, sand bowl, pond, and several well maintained trails within the property. Use of the campground for outdoor camping is free for members of Rush Creek council and can be used at any time with campground committee approval. Indoor camping is usually limited to winter time but the lodges can be reserved and rented at any time.
- 6 **Special help and support** can be also be obtained by contacting any of our executive board members who are able to assist by putting you in touch with one of our "DCE" team members (developers of counselor education), or even by a volunteer from another club that has experience and expertise in your area of interest.
